Footnotes

RESEARCHER settled off the pace off the rail, was boxed at the heels of Understatement into the final turn, eased three wide around the top two making his bid through the turn, lost some ground while dueling for the lead entering the stretch, raced clear from the sixteenth pole and held on well. AWESOME GEM, unhurried in mid track, closed toward contention nearing the final turn, entered the stretch five wide and had a strong finish for place. REDDING COLLIERY stalked the pace three wide, dueled to the lead past the quarter pole and remained a close factor through the upper stretch before reluctantly yielding the final sixteenth. INDIAN DANCE, unhurried about the three path, bid leaving the three eighths pole and finished evenly. UNDERSTATEMENT angled over for position inside and had his heels clipped in the process, rated the pace near the rail through the backstretch, was pressured at the rail through the final turn but weakened from the head of the lane. ACTING ZIPPY stalked the pace two deep and gave way after three quarters. GONE ASTRAY clipped the heels of Fiddlers Afleet into the first turn and was outrun from there. ENCAUSTIC steadied into the first turn, kept off the pace about the three path and showed no response on the final turn. NO ADVANTAGE was not a factor. FIDDLERS AFLEET clipped the heels of the early pacesetter, and had his heels clipped by Gone Astray into the first turn, settled off the pace inside then faded after a half mile. The stewards reviewed the incident into the first turn before declaring this race official.
