

SO MANY WAYS, steadied when pinched back leaving the starting gate, raced in the three path between horses the first turn, ranged up four deep on the far turn, took the lead near the sixteenth pole then edged away. R FREE ROLL, angled to the two path approaching the first turn, took the lead outside JAX AND JILL leaving the backstretch, opened a clear advantage on the final turn and tired the final sixteenth of a mile. MR HALL'S OPUS lacked speed, circled the far turn four deep and rallied. BLUEEYESINTHEREIN, angled to the three path entering the first turn, moved up in the three path between horses on the far turn and failed to sustain her bid. AWESOME MAMA worked her way over to the two path approaching the first turn, chased the pace while remaining in the second lane and weakened late. ILE ST. MOLLY lacked speed, failed to be a serious factor and was vanned off. GOLD EDGE lacked speed and was not a factor. JAX AND JILL accelerated to the early lead, angled to the inner rail entering the first turn, remained along the rail and gave way turning for home. THETALOVEANDMINE, four wide the first turn, was outrun and circled the far turn three deep.
